Award Description CDBG-R award to Hamilton County, Ohio. The following projects have been undertaken and completed with CDBG-R funding. Prairie Avenue Rehabilitation (855-1200 Prairie Ave Woodlawn, Ohio 45215): This project ground and resurfaced 715 linear feet of Prairie Avenue and provided new curbing. The project maximized job creation and provided economic benefit by investing in and improving the existing infrastructure within the Village. Sherman Avenue Improvements: (Sherman Avenue from 1600 block to the corp. limit; Norwood, OH 45212) Roadway was milled and repaved with new asphaltic concrete. Curb was replaced as necessary. A new traffic loop detector was installed and traffic signal equipment upgraded. Project was leveraged with \$240,000 in	

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additional funding previously obtained by the City.
 Golden View Acres HVAC Replacement (3589-3664 Greensfelder Lane, Sharonville OH 45241) : 35 HVAC units were replaced in this retirement community for low to moderate income seniors. Furnace units were upgraded from 60% to 80% efficiency. Air conditioning units were converted from 7 SEER to 13 SEER efficiency.
 Skyline Community Center Remodel (8500 Pippin Rd. Colerain, OH 45251):
 The Skyline Center provides recreation and other services to low/moderate income youth living in adjacent neighborhoods. The project converted existing storage space to create an additional room for various activities. It allows age appropriate activities to be conducted simultaneously in different areas of the building.
 Forest Park Sidewalk Replacement (various neighborhoods; Forest Park, OH 45240):
 Stimulus funds replaced sidewalks in four low/moderate income neighborhoods in the city. Approximately 9,900 square feet of sidewalk was replaced.
 Miami Avenue Rehabilitation, Phase 2:
 (North Miami Avenue, from 1 N. Miami to corp. limit; Cleves, OH 45030) Roadway was rehabilitated by milling the existing pavement and overlaying with new asphalt. The addition of the stimulus dollars allowed the extension of this work an additional four blocks nearly to the corporation line.
 South Wayne Avenue Improvements (from Wyoming Ave. to corp limit, Lockland OH 45215): With the addition

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stimulus funds, the scope of an existing project was expanded to include additional sections of roadway. Work included milling and replacement of existing pavement, catch basins, curbs and sidewalks.

Homeowner Rehabilitation Services (countywide): Funds were used to provide additional emergency and critical repairs to low income homeowners in Hamilton County. Project carried out by People Working Cooperatively, 4612 Paddock Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45229.

Urban Land Assistance Program (countywide; carried out by grantee): ULAP provided matching funds to Hamilton County communities to aid in the redevelopment of commercial and industrial sites, through environmental assessment, remediation and demolition of obsolete, blighted and vacant properties. CDBG-R dollars were used to fund portions of 16 ready-to-go demolition projects in 11 Hamilton County communities.

Mt. Airy Homeless Shelter (2660 Diehl Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45211): Carried out by Talbert House, funds were used to help close a funding gap of approximately \$300,000 per year for operational expenses. This project addressed Recovery Act goals by assisting those most impacted by the recession and by minimizing reductions in essential services.
