| 100172 – Maintenance Operations | <p>ORC 6103.02 – “The BOCC may acquire, construct, maintain, and operate any public water supply facilities within its county for one or more sewer districts and may provide for their protection and prevent their pollution and unnecessary waste. The board may negotiate and enter into a contract with any public agency or any person for the management, maintenance, operation and repair of the facilities on the behalf of the county...the County Sanitary Engineer...shall assist the board in the performance of its duties under this chapter...the board may adopt, publish, administer, and enforce rules</p> | 534,829 | 7.55 | 4,000 |

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| | <p>for the construction, maintenance, protection, and use of county-owned or county-operated public water supply facilities outside municipal corporations...”</p> <p>Under the above code, this program investigates and provides maintenance on stormwater drainage problems that occur within the unincorporated county limits. | 100180 – Stormwater Management | <p>Under the Hamilton County Stormwater Rules and Regulations approved by the BOCC in 1974, and revised as recently as 2007, “All public storm sewers in the unincorporated area of Hamilton County shall be controlled by the BOCC through the offices of the Hamilton County Public Works and the Hamilton County Engineer.</p> | 707,407 | 8.17 | 96,800 |
