<b>Court of Appeals</b>	ORC 2501.01 - states that the State <b>shall</b> be divided into twelve judicial court of appeals districts. The counties constituting the districts are as follows: (A) First district - Hamilton ORC 2501.18 - states that upon written requisition of the Court of Appeals, the clerk of the Court of Appeals <b>shall</b> provide such courts with necessary stationery, and furnish for their use reports of the decisions of the courts of the state, with the latest edition of the Revised Code, digests, and such other law books as such court require, which books <b>shall</b> be the property of the county. The expense incurred by such clerk <b>shall</b> be paid from the county treasury on the warrant of the county auditor. The Board of County Commissioners <b>must</b> provide a room for holding court and a consultation room for the judges. Cause such rooms to be properly furnished, heated, ventilated, lighted, and kept clean and in good order, and provide such other conveniences, as the court deems necessary.
