Plaintiff-appellant Keith Loop appeals from the decision of the trial court granting summary judgment in favor of defendants-appellees Plumbers, Pipe Fitters

& MES Union Local 392, Jim Higgins, Paula Allphin, Dennis Johnson, Emcor, DeBra-Kuempel, Ed Ulrich, Fidelity Investments, and Jody Tolson-Crawford.

In his single assignment of error, Loop argues that the trial court erred in granting summary judgment in favor of the defendants.

Under Civ.R. 56(C), a motion for summary judgment may be granted only if there are no genuine issues of material fact, and if, with the evidence construed most strongly in favor of the nonmoving party, reasonable minds can only conclude that the moving party is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. *Vonderhaar v. Cincinnati*, 191 Ohio App.3d 229, 2010-Ohio-6289, 945 N.E.2d 603, ¶17. We review a ruling on summary judgment de novo. *Jorg v. Cincinnati Black United Front*, 153 Ohio App.3d 258, 2003-Ohio-3668, 792 N.E.2d 781, ¶6.

Having reviewed the entire record, we hold that the trial court correctly entered summary judgment in favor of the defendants. We overrule Loop's single assignment of error and affirm the judgment of the trial court.

Further, a certified copy of this judgment entry shall be sent to the trial court under App.R. 27. Costs shall be taxed under App.R. 24.
