

**PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS
FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2002
DISTRICT 2 - HAMILTON COUNTY
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
(LTIP) PROJECTS**

- 1) Hamilton County – Clough/Wolfangel Intersection Improvement - Estimated cost of \$1,520,000.00. Project is located at the intersection of Clough Road and Wolfangel Road, 900 feet in each direction from the intersection. Project includes relocating both legs of Wolfangel Road to align the intersection, add left turn lanes on all four legs of the intersection, reprofile Clough Road, install storm sewer system, install concrete box culvert, signalize the intersection. A grant of \$1,216,400.00 was approved for the project. Construction is to be complete by December 31, 2003.

- 2) Harrison – New Haven Road Improvements - Estimated cost of \$1,000,000.00. Project limits are from the bridge over I-74 to Carolina Trace Road. Project consists of full depth pavement repair, install new storm sewer system, widen roadway up to 40 feet and install left turn lanes at Carolina Trace, surface with asphaltic concrete, signalize the intersection. A grant of \$800,000.00 was approved for this project. Construction is to be complete by June 1, 2003.

- 3) Springdale – East Kemper Road, Phase 2 - Estimated cost of \$1,101,420.00. Project limits are from 590 feet west of Century Boulevard to and including the intersection of Chesterdale Road. Also, approximately 280 feet on Commons Drive and 550 feet on Century Boulevard. Project consists of providing an eastbound third lane, additional turn lanes for both east and west directions, new right-only lane for southbound at Commons Drive, new right-only lane for northbound at Century Boulevard, new additional southbound lane on Century from Kemper Road to 550 feet south of Kemper. Complete resurfacing of Kemper Road and Century Boulevard. Install video detection for Century-Kemper intersection as part of the signal modification. A grant of \$440,568.00 was approved for this project. Construction is to be complete by May 30, 2003.

- 4) Loveland – Rich Road Improvements - Estimated cost of \$2,059,250.00. Project limits are from West Loveland Avenue to Fallis Road. Project consists of milling and overlaying existing roadway surface, excavate to reprofile roadway to sufficient grade for adequate sight distance, widen roadway to current standard width, upgrade storm sewer system, install new concrete curbs, install sidewalk entire length of project, install left turn lanes, upgrade traffic signals. A grant of \$1,029,625.00 was approved for this project. Construction is to be complete by August 30, 2003.

- 5) Hamilton County – Harrison Road/Dry Fork Road Relocation/Widening Project – Estimated cost of \$2,100,000.00. Project is located in Harrison Township at the intersection of Harrison Road and Dry Fork Road. Project consists of relocating Harrison Road, extending Dry Fork Road to meet the relocated Harrison Road, widen Dry Fork Road to 60 feet, install left turn lanes, install storm drainage system, and install traffic signals. A grant of \$1,050,000.00 was approved for the project. Construction is to be complete by December 31, 2003.

- 6) Forest Park – Mill Road Repair & Improvements, Phase 2 - Estimated Cost of \$1,155,000.00. Project limits are from Waycross Road to Kemper Road. Project consists of repairing failed base areas, widen road to provide a 22 feet pavement and 4 feet paved shoulder, install raised pavement markers, replace curbs at intersections, curb ramps, install turn lanes and traffic signals. A grant of \$674,930.00 was approved for the project. Construction is to be complete by June 27, 2003.
