WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

The Hamilton County Family and Children First Council is sponsoring an all day training workshop for employees of agencies that serve children and families. The training will focus on the child serving systems, the services they offer for children and families, when it is appropriate to use those services and how to access them.

Understanding the various social service systems and how to use them is often a confusing part of the job of social service workers. The Inter System Training offers fifteen small workshops designed to instruct social service workers in what they need to know to best help their clients. Each small workshop will give basic information about that system, including how to recognize when referral to that agency is indicated, and what to expect for clients if they are involved with that system.

Training participants will have an opportunity to attend four different workshops during the course of the day and will receive a manual with key information about each of the systems presenting at this workshop, including telephone phone numbers and names of intake personnel.

The Family and Children First Council has sponsored the training annually for over ten years. It has been an extremely popular training, which is usually sold out prior to the cutoff date. **Therefore, those interested in attending and being assigned to specific workshops should register as early as possible.**

Registration fee is **\$35.00**, which includes lunch, CE credits, parking and the Inter System manual. Payment and the registration form must be received in the Council Office **no later than April 3. SPACE IS LIMITED, SO SIGN UP NOW!** Registrations will be accepted on a first come first served basis.
