

## **Stormwater Zoning Code Project**

The purpose of the Stormwater Zoning Code Project is to research and report findings on nationwide best management practices that could be incorporated in zoning codes to address stormwater urban runoff issues.

The task force studied the language and concepts traditionally used in local zoning codes identifying areas where changes may be possible by incorporating the appropriate language to achieve a better stormwater management.

### **The Stormwater Zoning Code Project includes:**

- A 60-minute presentation followed by a questions and answers session. The presentation includes a menu of zoning code changes that can be used for residential and non residential development that if implemented will reduce runoff
- A compilation of an extensive library of reference material that includes model ordinances, guidelines, case studies and websites
- Free on-site presentation, training materials for all participants, and a CD with the PowerPoint presentation for the jurisdiction to keep and use as needed
- A program that Hamilton County jurisdictions can use to partially fulfill the Public Education and Outreach / Public Involvement and Participation minimum control measures requirements as outlined in the Compliance Guide for Member Communities Binder - Hamilton County Storm Water District - (HCSWD).
