



## **The Jewish Hospital Mobile Mammography Unit**

### **Bringing the best in detection to Hamilton County!**

The Jewish Hospital Mobile Mammography Units make screening mammography quick and easy. The self-contained, 38-foot vans are staffed by female radiology technologists who specialize in mammography. The units use the same FDA and Mammography Quality Standards Act (MQSA)-approved equipment as the hospital. Mammograms on the mobile units only take about 15 minutes.

All mammograms performed on the mobile units are screening mammograms—the most common way to detect early-stage breast cancer.

#### **Program facts**

- The Jewish Hospital utilizes the latest diagnostic technologies available to provide the highest quality of mammography care.
- The Mobile Mammography Program meets the standards of the American College of Radiology (ACR) and the Mammography Quality Standards Act (MQSA).
- All mammography films are interpreted by board-certified radiologists, experienced in the interpretation of mammograms.
- The Mobile Mammography Program provides a low-cost, efficient method of breast screening to the community.
- The Mobile Mammography Program offers an alternative to hospital-based radiological facilities.
- All Mobile Mammography Units are staffed by female radiological technologists, specially trained in mammographic imaging.
- All Mobile Mammography patients are provided with educational information on breast disease and breast self-examination.
- The Mobile Mammography Units utilize the R2 ImageChecker, a computer-aided detection (CAD) system that detects 23.4 percent more breast cancers than mammography alone.
