




2010 Median Age by County




**Percent Change 2000-2010






Percent of 2010 Population Under 5 Years of Age by County



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


Percent of 2000 Population Under 5 Years of Age by County






Percent of 2000 Population Under 18 Years of Age by County



**Percent of 2010 Working Population:




Percent of 2000 Population Over 65 Years of Age by County




Percent Change 2000-2010 in Population Over 65 Years of Age by County

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
