


# cincinnati metropolitan statistical area

The Cincinnati Metropolitan Statistical Area, or CMSA, is comprised of fifteen counties in Ohio, Kentucky, and Indiana. Included in this selection are Brown, Butler, Clermont, Hamilton and Warren counties from Ohio; Boone, Bracken, Campbell, Kenton, Gallatin, Grant and Pendleton counties in Kentucky; and Dearborn, Franklin and Ohio counties in Indiana.

Despite having the greatest decrease in population between 1970 and 2010, Hamilton County has remained the region's most populous jurisdiction. Even though the population of Hamilton County has been on the decline, the greater CMSA has been increasing in population since the 1970's, from 1,668,420 people to 2,130,151 in 2010.

Bracken County, Kentucky and Franklin County, Indiana were added to the CMSA in 1990. Although their addition has helped increase the CMSA population numbers in subsequent years, excluding these two additions to the region would still yield a population increase of 430,156 people, or 25.8%, since 1970.





The Cincinnati Metropolitan Statistical Area has followed a similar pattern of dispersal compared to Hamilton County. Many of the outlying counties that make up the CMSA have increased their population while Hamilton County has decreased. Butler, Warren, and Clermont counties, have seen the largest population gains between 1970 and 2010, in the range of 100,001 to 150,000 people, and between 30,001 and 60,000 in the 10 year period from 2000 to 2010 alone.

The only county in the CMSA to have a negative population change since 1970 is Hamilton, which lost 123,570 or 13.3 percent of its total population. Because of the states close proximity to Indiana and Kentucky, those states and their counties included in the CMSA have also gained population. Boone and Kenton County, both in Kentucky and bordering Hamilton County to the south, have gained between 30,001 and 100,000 people between the 1970 and 2010 census.






**Numerical Change 2000-2010 in Total Population by County**




**Percent Change 2000-2010 in Total Population by County**




**Numerical Change 1970-2010 in Total Population by County**

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





# cmsa: total population by jurisdiction


2010 Total Population of CMSA

Population density depicts the average number of people per square mile for a given county within the CMSA. While Hamilton County does not have the greatest land area within the region, it does have a significantly higher population density than the other counties that make up the CMSA.

Hamilton, Butler, and Kenton counties have remained three of the four most densely populated counties from 1970 to 2010. Some of the outlying areas, however, have seen the greatest increases in population density during that same time period. Between 1970 and 2010, Boone County, Kentucky has seen both the greatest actual increase in people per square mile, as well as the greatest percentage increase, with 349.5 and 262.8% increases respectively.

Similar to the census numbers for population change, Hamilton County is the only jurisdiction in the region to experience a decline in population density, which occurred at a rate of 300.3 people per square mile, or 13.2% from the 1970 census to the 2010 census.





## Numerical Change in Population Density 1970-2010





The proportional distribution of population for the Cincinnati Metropolitan Statistical Area is important to identifying patterns of growth and decline in population by county. It is important when comparing county populations within the CMSA.

Hamilton County held the greatest proportion of the population within Ohio and the CMSA between 1970 and 2010, and Ohio held the greatest proportion of the population of the three states within the CMSA during the same time period. Although Hamilton County still holds the largest proportion of the population, they have also lost the greatest proportion of the total population between 1970 and 2010, at a rate of 31.2 percent. Hamilton County dropped from 54.7 percent in 1970 to 37.7 percent in 2010. The only other CMSA counties to lose proportion of the CMSA population were Bracken, Campbell, and Kenton counties in Kentucky.

While Hamilton County was losing huge percentages of its population compared to most of the other counties within the CMSA, places like Warren County, Ohio, Boone County, Kentucky, and Dearborn County, Indiana, gained population at the rate of 97.7, 187.7, and 35.1 percent respectively.






**Proportional Distribution of 1970 CMSA Population by County**


