


# race analysis

In order to gauge a better understanding of the demographics in Hamilton County, this analysis examines race and ethnicity of the county population and how it has changed from 2000 to 2010. As the county becomes more diverse, keeping track of how the county demographic is changing is crucial. This data is especially useful when developing public literature or signage, so that all cultures' languages can be taken into account.


As established by the United States Census Bureau, race is broken down into the following categories: White, Black or African American, Asian, American Indian and Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and Some Other Race. Due to the incremental numbers of American Indian and Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and Some Other Race within Hamilton County, this analysis has grouped these three classifications together as "Some Other Race."

Although the U.S. Census Bureau breaks down the multiracial population into several different numerical categories, this analysis identifies any person whose descent consists of more than one race as "Two or More Races."

The U.S. Census Bureau also distinctly classifies Hispanic or Latino as an ethnicity, distinctly different from race. Therefore, any data in reference to the Hispanic or Latino population refers to persons of any race who report themselves as having Hispanic or Latino heritage.

From 2000 to 2010, the White population was the only demographic to lose numbers, declining from 72% of Hamilton County to 69%. In fact, all other racial and ethnic groups in the county grew over the past decade. Of those to increase population, the Hispanic or Latino population grew the most with a 116% increase, changing their presence in the county from just over 1% to nearly 3%.

All of the demographic groups are broken down individually in further detail in the upcoming pages of this document. Each racial or ethnic group is introduced with a table explaining the percent of that demographic with respect to the total population, including the number and percent change from 2000-2010. Following that data are maps to visually represent areas of change in the county.

The most prominent racial or ethnic group in Hamilton County is white. However, as previously indicated, the white demographic is the only group to have declined over the past decade. Taking a look at the map on page 20, municipalities along the east and west borders of Hamilton County are most heavily concentrated with the county's white population. Coincidentally, these areas are also some of the least dense in county, both in persons per square mile and housing units per square mile.


Data was not attained for censuses prior to 2000, but it appears that much of the shifting of the white population that occurred from the city into the less dense areas of the county occurred prior to 2000. There were only eleven county subdivisions that gained white population in the past decade--Amberley Village, Cheviot, Cleves, Crosby Township, Green Township, Harrison, Lincoln Heights, Miami Township, Newtown, North Bend and Woodlawn--all others lost white population to some extent. The only noticeable pattern of this population shift is a higher concentration of whites in the western, less developed municipalities of the county. Of the jurisdictions to lose white population, Cincinnati, Colerain Township, Forest Park, Norwood, and Springdale were among those who lost the most.

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# black or african american population




The second largest racial group in Hamilton County is black or African American. Looking at the map on page 24, the jurisdictions with the most black or African American population are concentrated in the center of the county, in Cincinnati and west of the I-75 corridor. Contrary to the white population's living patterns, these areas tend to be more dense with people and housing units.

Among the many jurisdictions that grew their African American population from 2000-2010, Colerain Township, Forest Park, North College Hill, and Springfield Township topped the charts, all with at least a 1,000 person increase. Only seven of the county's forty-nine municipalities lost black population, but those who lost most were Cincinnati and Lincoln Heights. The black population shift is somewhat similar to that of whites in that African Americans are also slowly moving away from the urban core into the surrounding new developing areas.




**Numerical Change 2000-2010 in Black or African American Population per Jurisdiction**




Although Hamilton County's Asian population numbers are miniscule compared to the two categories previously discussed, the patterns of their concentration are noteworthy. The Percent Asian Map on the next page shows an indisputable centralizing of Hamilton County's Asian demographic in the northeast corner of the county. Over 9% of Blue Ash and Symmes Township's populations are of Asian descent. In terms of density, these two communities rank around the middle for people and housing units per square mile. However, these areas have been steadily growing from 1970 to 2000 and have only declined mildly in the past decade.

Of those jurisdictions with a growing Asian population, Anderson, Blue Ash, Cincinnati, Green Township, Montgomery, Sycamore Township, Symmes Township, and The Village Of Indian Hill rank at the top, all with over a 100 person increase since 2000. Overall, the county's Asian population has grown nearly 17% since 2000--the fourth largest demographic increase in the county.



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# some other race population

As previously mentioned, "Some Other Race" for this study is made up of the sum of the American Indian and Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and Some Other Race groups as classified by the U.S. Census Bureau. Of the five demographic groups to increase over the past ten years, the some other race population gained the least amount of new residents for the county. In fact, the some other race demographic now takes up a smaller proportion of the county compared to what it did in 2000. This could be attributed to a less confusing census form that led many Hispanic or Latino residents to fill out the form differently in 2010 than in 2000. Additionally, not one jurisdiction in Hamilton County has a presence greater than or equal to 1% for some other race.

Of those to lose their some other race population, the City of Cincinnati tops the chart with a decrease of 151 persons. Contrarily, Colerain Township gained the most some other race citizens, totaling over 90. The closest municipalities behind Colerain are Anderson Township, Delhi Township, Forest Park, St. Bernard, Silverton, and Springdale, all with around 30 new residents. In total, Hamilton County only gained 205 new inhabitants in this category.


Ranking in third with the largest numerical increase in population for the county is the Two or More Races Population. As mentioned, this category consists of any person in Hamilton County that identifies as having two, three, four, or more races in their genealogy. Although no county jurisdiction has more than 3.5% of their population made up of two or more races, this racial group appears to be universally on the rise. Only five municipalities lost part of their multiracial population, none of which exceeded 25 people.

The communities with the highest concentration of their two or more races population include Addyston, Arlington Heights, Elmwood Place, Forest Park, Greenhills, and Lockland, all with just over 3%. Cincinnati had by far the largest numerical increase in this demographic, totaling just over 1,500 people. The closest county subdivision behind Cincinnati is Colerain Township, with just over 550 new multiracial inhabitants. Overall, the two or more races population increased by over 50% with just over 5,000 new residents.








**Numerical Change 2000-2010 in Two or More Races Population per Jurisdiction**

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# hispanic or latino population

The total Hispanic or Latino population in Hamilton County for 2010 was about 2.6% of around 800,000 people. Having more than doubled over the past decade, the Hispanic or Latino population is quickly becoming a more prominent demographic in Hamilton County. Cincinnati holds by far the most of this demographic with almost 8,500 persons, but Springdale is this ethnic group's most heavily concentrated municipality in the county with nearly 18% of its population being Hispanic or Latino. Colerain Township and Forest Park also hold a noteworthy number of Hispanic or Latino inhabitants, each with over 1,000.


Only four municipalities in the county lost numbers from the Hispanic or Latino population: Evendale, Harrison Township, Lincoln Heights, and Milford. Most other communities grew this demographic so much that their percent change exceeded 100%. Overall, this group has grown more than any other in the county since 2000, now with a total population of just over 11,000.


