

DISCLAIMER:

Jurisdiction comparisons may result in inaccurate conclusions for the following reasons:

- the source of the data varies amongst jurisdictions
- crimes are sometimes reported differently amongst jurisdictions and neighborhoods
- some communities lack multi-year data and some report for different years
- the city of Cincinnati Police Department does not always use the exact neighborhood statistical boundaries defined by the US Census Bureau
- crime rates are calculated based on resident population rather than daytime (employees and shoppers) population
