An unfinished or flood resistant enclosure, usable solely for parking of vehicles, building access or limited storage, in an area other than basement, is not considered a building's lowest floor; provided, that such enclosure is not built so as to render the structure in violation of the applicable design requirements for enclosed areas below the lowest floor. All as-built elevations shown shall be referenced to NGVD (mean sea level datum) and shall indicate the description and elevation of the public bench mark, or marks used in determining the as-built elevations
