Dear Mr. Burke:

On August 23, 1995 two petitions for referendums were filed with the County Auditor pursuant to section 305.31, et seq., of the Revised Code.

These petitions for the Referendum on County Permissive Tax, part A and part B, were displayed from August 23, 1995 through September 11, 1995 in the County Auditor's Office. Five days from the date of receipt of the petitions, the Auditor wrote certified letters to the Tax Commissioner of Ohio and the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners pursuant to R.C. 5739.021.

Following the period of public display, and on September 11, 1995, the Auditor transmitted the petitions to the Board of Elections with the required certified copies of relevant resolutions pursuant to R.C. 305.31 having determined that the petitions were valid and sufficient as to all matters other than the number of valid signatures.

On September 15, 1995 the petitions were returned to the Auditor by the Board of Elections with an accompanying letter advising that "at least 28,049 qualified electors in Hamilton County have signed part petition A and at least 27,207 qualified electors have signed part petition B." The Board of Elections further noted that "in the last general election for the office of Governor in the State of Ohio, ...268,387 votes were cast in Hamilton County for the office of Governor."

Having now received word from the Board of Elections about the number of qualified electors who have signed each petition and the number of votes cast in Hamilton County for the office of Governor in the last general election, and having no basis for questioning the sufficiency and validity of the petitions, I again certify to you the sufficiency and validity of the petitions as to all matters according to law.

To the County Auditor of the County of Hamilton, Ohio:

We, the undersigned, Electors of the County of Hamilton, Ohio, respectfully petition that the resolutions relative to the levying of a Sales and Use tax passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 26th day of July, 1995, be submitted to the electors of Hamilton County for their approval or rejection at the next Primary Election held in an even-numbered year.

The following is a full and correct copy of the titles and text of the resolutions sought to be referred:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LEVYING A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF R.C. 5739.026.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5739.026 the Board of County Commissioners desires to levy a one-half of one percent tax for the purpose of providing additional general revenues for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has complied with the statutory conditions precedent for the adoption of this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5739.026 the Board of County Commissioners hereby levies a tax at the rate of one-half of one percent for the purpose of providing additional revenue for the County's general fund. This tax is to be levied for a continuing period of time and is to be effective October 1, 1995, or as otherwise provided by law. This tax is in addition to the tax imposed by R.C. 5739.02 and the taxes levied pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5739.021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be delivered to the Tax Commissioner of the State of Ohio as provided by law.

ADOPTED at the regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, this 26th day of July, 1995.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, LEVYING A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT STORAGE, USE OR OTHER CONSUMPTION TAX PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF R.C. 5741.023.

By the Board:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5739.026, a county that levies a tax pursuant to that section of the Revised Code is required to levy a tax at the same rate pursuant to R.C. 5741.023; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5739.026, the Board has levied a one half of one percent Sales Tax; and

WHEREAS, the Board has complied with the statutory conditions precedent for the adoption of this Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to the provisions of R.C. 5741.023, does hereby levy a tax at the rate of one-half of one percent. This tax is to be effective October 1, 1995, or as otherwise provided by law, and shall remain in effect until the Sales Tax levied by the Board under R.C. 5739.026, effective October 1, 1995, is repealed. This tax is for the purpose of providing additional general revenues for the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be delivered to the Tax Commissioner of the State of Ohio as provided by law.
