
River City Correctional Center continually strives to improve its efforts with deterring acts of sexual harassment and abuse perpetrated against its facility residents. River City has imposed disciplinary action—up to and, including termination—for those staff who have violated agency sexual harassment and/or sexual abuse policies. With respect to resident-on-resident acts of sexual harassment and abuse, River City has imposed disciplinary action commensurate with the offence. Moreover, those residents who remained in the River City program after violating facility PREA guidelines were offered additional behavior modification therapy—and enhanced monitoring—to aid them with compliance

River City undertook—and initiated—a number of facility improvement projects in 2019—with the aim of bolstering its adherence to PREA standards. LCD display monitors (pictured below) were installed in three areas of the facility (main lobby, intake area, and rear administration), all of which display information about River City’s PREA Zero Tolerance policy, and the various hotline numbers available for those who have sustained sexual abuse/harassment in the facility. These monitors are visible to both facility residents, and to anyone who enters the main lobby of the facility.


Additionally, River City is in the process of acquiring four additional cameras, which will be installed in areas of the facility where there are currently blind spots.




